## TRAVELLING TO THE FESTIVAL

Please think about the best way to get to the festival to minimise your CO2 impact. One person driving in a car alone can emit ten times the amount of CO2 than if you travel in a full coach. Of course coming by public transport isn't going to work for everyone so if you drive please try and fill up the seats - it really will make a difference.



#### SHUTTLE BUS FOR STAFF

Reduce the impact of getting to the festival, jump on the train. We have a shuttle bus to meet you at Halesworth train station on **Wednesday afternoon 2pm to 8pm.** It will drive right into the festival site (up close to the campground). Just jump off the train, and look for the shuttle bus signs. Cost is £2 per ride, pay as you get on. There won't be a shuttle for staff at the end of the festival, they'll need to get on the general audience shuttles, so please tell staff check out the times for those before they commit to travelling by public transport.

## STAFF SHUTTLE BUS: Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July - 2pm to 8pm. Halesworth Train Station to Latitude Festival Site
