

CLEAN CREW CAMPS & WORK AREAS



Apart from the Carbon Footprint, festival LANDFILL FOOTPRINTS are also quite huge. We have audience projects in place to encourage everyone to bring less STUFF, to re-use and to actively recycle. As you can imagine, the waste and cleaning crew have enough to do mopping up after the punters. This year we hope you will join us in making Clean Crew Camps a reality. If your team stays and camps up, please encourage them to pick up their rubbish, to recycle what they can, and most importantly, pack up their camping gear and take it home with them.

This is what we want to see at the end of the show...

This year you will have noticed that leaving your crew camp and work areas free of rubbish will have been included in your contract. **Crew Compounds** should be left 'litter free' including removing litter from cabins, tents, tent pegs, fire pits, caravan gas bottles, drinks cans, plastic bags, food etc... **Working Areas** should be 'clear of commercial waste' including all tent pegs, flooring, stillages, water pipe, cables, carpet, rope, paint tins, timber etc...

Contractors who don't comply with this request will be liable to a financial penalty. The costs incurred by Festival Republic to rectify your compounds or remove discarded work materials from site will be passed directly on to you &, if necessary, deducted from the balance of your final payment.

This year we ask that you appoint someone from within your team to make sure your crews pick up their litter, recycle what they can, and take any work materials and camping gear home with them. Before you leave site there will be a sign off procedure with your appointed litter manager and the Site Office or Event Waste Manager to check that your crew compounds are litter free and working areas are clear of commercial waste.
